We are hiring an experienced, full-time listening and spoken language trained teacher of the deaf and hard of hearing to be a part of our team that provides developmentally appropriate classroom instruction to our students from preschool through elementary.

Classroom teachers at CHSC are responsible for developing individualized goals for children and their families, and facilitating language-rich learning activities that support their growth in all areas, including audition, receptive and expressive language, speech, cognition, social pragmatics and pre-academics. The lead teacher works closely with an Early Childhood Educator, SLPs and audiologist.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Masters Degree in deaf education with an emphasis on listening and spoken language
- BC Teacher's Certificate
- Classroom teaching experience; general education and specialized classes for children who are deaf and hard of hearing an asset

This is a permanent, full-time (September to June school year) position beginning September 2021.
