EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATOR ASSISTANT

Children's Hearing and Speech Centre of BC is an independent Listening and Spoken Language Centre providing services to children and their families from Birth through Grade 3 (on site) and to mainstreamed students in Grades K-12 throughout B.C. www.childrenshearing.ca

We are hiring a part-time (30 hrs/week) Early Childhood Educator Assistant to join our multi-disciplinary team. The ECE will work directly with classroom Teachers of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing within our centre-based programs, providing high quality care and creative programming. Working in collaboration with the teachers, speech language pathologists and other ECEs, this position is responsible for supporting children in the Centre's licensed and academic programs as well as providing Before and After School care. ECEs will ensure that children are well supervised and will assist the classroom teacher in providing developmentally and academically appropriate programming in keeping with the Centre's listening and spoken language philosophy.

Qualifications and Requirements

- Currently enrolled in an accredited Early Childhood Education program
- Have completed a minimum of one ECE program course
- Current ECE Assistant license to practice in BC
- Ability to work collaboratively with other ECEs, teachers and speech language pathologists
- Experience working with children with hearing loss is an asset
- First Aid is an asset
- Must submit to a criminal record check (working with vulnerable persons classification) prior to the start of employment
- Must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. Proof of vaccination status will be required.

Job Responsibilities & Duties

Reporting to the Director of Education of Children's Hearing & Speech Centre of BC ('CHSC'), duties will include:

- Provide support to the Teacher of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing
- Assist in supervision of children in the classroom and on the playground
- Assist in supervision of children in our summer child care program
- Take part in school activities during work hours
- Assist in supporting language development as directed by the classroom teacher, SLPs and other members of the team
- Participate in professional development to keep certification current
