We are hiring one Early Childhood Educator for a part-time maternity leave position in our Early Learning Program for children ages 3 to 5. This position would begin December 2, 2024 and run through June 30, 2025, working 3 days per week in December and then 2 days per week in 2025. Shifts would be 8am to 4pm, or 9am to 5pm (8 hour day includes ½ hour unpaid lunch break).

CHSC has been providing listening and spoken language programs for children with hearing loss since 1963. Come join our highly trained team and gain valuable experience working with children, including those with hearing loss.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Valid ECE certificate
- Valid First Aid certificate
- Ability to work collaboratively with other ECEs
- Must submit to a criminal record check (working with vulnerable persons classification) prior to the start of employment

Job Responsibilities and Duties:

- Supervision of children in the classroom, on the playground and on field trips
- Collaborating in the preparation of teaching materials, art and other activities
- Supporting language development as directed by the classroom teacher, SLPs and other members of the team
- Provide positive behavioural support in collaboration with the other members of the team
- Support social development
- Assist in preparing the classroom and in cleaning protocols
